FAQ - Frequently Asked Questions



The Si View Before & After School Program offers a safe and enriching place for all Snoqualmie Valley School District students. Through activities such as swimming, arts and crafts, science projects, sports, occasional field trips, and special homework time, participants gain new skills, create lasting friendships, and develop healthy habits. This is a great program for kids who want to be active and academically successful. The Si View Before & After School Program is housed at Si View Community Center. After School programs are also available at Fall City Elementary School and North Bend Elementary School.

When does registration open for Before and After School Programs?

2019-20 School Year Care registration opens Tuesday June 4th, 9am. You can register online at www.siviewpark.org, by phone (425) 831-1900 or in person at Si View Community Center.

How much does it cost?

Program fees vary depending on which options you choose. Your options include Monthly Enrollment which provides before / after care for all school days or 2+ Days Per Week Enrollment for those needing 2-3 days a week of regularly-scheduled before / after school care. Resident rates are offered for all Si View MPD residents. 2019-20 pricing will be available on our website by May 10th.

Which schools do these programs serve?

All Snoqualmie Valley School District elementary school students can attend the program. Schools that do not offer transportation to our program sites have a minimum enrollment requirement for van service.

How does transportation work?

Transportation to/from Si View is provided to NBE and OES students via school district busses while SES, CVES, and TRES are shuttled by Si View vans.

What are your hours of operation? Do you operate on non-school days?

6:30am—School Start and After School—6:30pm. Oftentimes, we do offer no school day camps, which you can register and pay separately for. During the summer we offer a variety of exciting and fun camp options as well!

How quickly do these programs fill up?

Typically, spaces fill up within the first day of registration. We encourage you to sign up for a waitlist if needed, as spaces do often open up after registration.

What is the staff to child ratio?

Our child to staff ratio is typically at 1 child to every 10 leaders, with a maximum of 1 to 12.

Is there a snack provided?

YES! Each day your child will receive a snack at our program. This is a snack, and not a full meal so please send extra food if you feel our child will need it.

How does registration work?

At the time of registration you will need to pay an annual registration fee of \$50. This fee holds a space in the program for your child for the school year. The registration fee is non-refundable/nontransferable. Monthly tuition will be due by the 5th business day of each month.
