



Si View Metro Parks Scholarship Information

Thank you for your interest in Si View Metro Parks and our parks and recreation programs. Our goal is to ensure parks and recreation opportunities are available to all interested people, regardless of income. Eligibility for Scholarships:

1. Scholarships are available for youth and persons with disabilities.
2. Scholarships are offered for programs administered by Si View Metro Parks.
3. Applicant(s) must attend and/or live within the Snoqualmie Valley School District.
4. Applicant(s) must meet income guidelines listed below.

The amount of the scholarship award is based on the family income guideline. The following guideline is used as the basis for eligibility:

Example: If your family size is two and your income is \$21,400 or less you are eligible for a 75% scholarship.

1. Scholarship awards are partial and will not exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) per calendar year, per person.
2. Scholarship eligibility is based on household income. If multiple households are approved for a scholarship for the same individual, the \$250 annual maximum award is split between the households.
3. Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first served basis.
4. Some programs are subject to one scholarship enrollment per student in the same session. You may register for additional classes at full cost.

How to Apply/Approval Process:

1. Complete the scholarship application. Attach proof of income (most recent W2, tax return, pay stub or other documentation).
2. If you feel that you have extenuating circumstances not evidenced by the above information, you may submit a statement explaining your current situation. Please include it with the application.

4. Please submit applications as early as possible. The review process takes 10 business days/2 calendar weeks. If approved registration will take place through Melissa Pasley. Ms. Pasley will contact you to let you know if approved. Any balance not covered by the partial scholarship must be paid at the time of registration. NOTE: A scholarship application does not register the participant, nor does it reserve space in a program.
