Stay at Home Order extended

The Governor's Stay at Home order has been extended to May 31, with a phased approach for re-opening of services. We are closely tracking the State's plan and following guidance for re-opening recreation programs and facilities. During this transition time, we realize there will be a need for childcare and youth programming so that parents can get back to work. This is a priority for us and we are committed to providing expanded childcare and youth services during this time.

Si View facilities will remain closed in phase 1, with the exception of passive use of park spaces and childcare for families of essential workers. We anticipate partial re-opening of our active outdoor recreation facilities such as park restrooms, bike park and the skate park in phase 2. Limited recreation programming can resume in phase 3. Currently it does not seem likely that most large summer events such as the Theater in the Park will be able to move forward. However, our Farmers Market, as an essential service, has received a conditional operating permit starting June 11.

Many outdoor recreation areas will begin re-opening May 5 across the State. Please recreate responsibly and follow the latest public health guidelines and know your local area closures that may still be in effect. The Disc Golf course at South Fork Landing will re-open on May 5 with new safety measures in place.

Here are the latest program, facility and park updates:

All Si View programs and facility rentals are SUSPENDED due to Governor's Stay at Home Order until further notice, except childcare for families of essential workers. We understand the impact these closures have on our community members and continue to work on processing refunds, reschedules and addressing questions and concerns. All Si View parks and trails where social distancing can be maintained remain OPEN. For everyone's safety, we ask you not to recreate in groups and encourage you to continue to use the park closest to where you live. If you encounter others, maintain a minimum of 6-foot distance.

The Disc Golf at South Fork Landing opens May 5 with safety requirements posted on site. Please follow all posted notices.

All Si View playgrounds and active recreation areas remain CLOSED. This includes playground equipment, sports courts (tennis, basketball, pickleball, volleyball), baseball fields, soccer fields, skate park, pump track, climbing wall, picnic shelters and the like. All recreation areas where it could be difficult to maintain recommended social distancing guidelines are closed.

Outdoor restrooms are currently CLOSED. Please go, before you go out.

Si View administrative offices are CLOSED to the public, with administration team working remotely. District staff is available by phone during normal business hours of 9am-5pm Monday through Friday at (425) 831-1900.
