FIELD TRIP DETAILS

On February 20th and 21st we will be going to plant trees at Lake Sammamish State Park with the Mountains to Sound Greenway team in their native plant nursery! Please send your child with lunch, two snacks, water, closed toed sturdy shoes, long pants (we'll be working with tools), rain gear and extra layers!

Please note, transportation will be provided in Si View Vans and will be cancelled in case of icy roads or snow. Children under age 8 will be seated in booster seats.

Half the group will go on Wednesday, while the other half will go on Thursday in order to allow for a small group experience. Children will be assigned to either Wednesday or Thursday's field trip once the week's roster is finalized.
