Upcoming Dates:

Mid-Winter Break: NO classes are held – February 20, 23, 24

Spring Break: NO classes are held – April 10, 13, 14

Parent Watch Week: Parents will be invited to come in to the last five minutes of class and take a cellphone video the week of **March 20-24**. These videos are a tool to help your dancer practice at home for the recital.

Week of Recital: Classes are scheduled during recital week. Individual teachers will call other classes if need be, otherwise, it is just your rehearsal call time at Si View Community Center.

The instructors reserve the right to hold an extra class if they feel the class or individuals need extra rehearsal time. An email will be sent out as we get closer informing parents if there are changes to your dancers' schedule during recital week.

Rehearsals

This is the time when dancers get to see where they perform and have a chance to dance on stage before their show. It is so important to allow the dancers this opportunity to learn about the rehearsal process and how to be an audience member. This rehearsal allows them a calm atmosphere for their first (for many dancers) experience performing so that they will be the most confident and secure on the day of the show. This rehearsal is also important for parents as you will see first-hand how the show is put together.

Rehearsals will be on Friday, May 5 at Si View Community Center gym. Arrival and call times will be announced to each class as the date gets closer.

Please be sure to arrive on-time so that we can stay on schedule.

Attire

Costumes will be provided by our dance instructors, as that is included in the recital fee.

Dancers will be responsible for their own tights/pants, socks, shoes, hairstyle. Direction on attire for each class will be announced as the recital dates gets closer.



Parents: What you need to know for the show!

Make-up: Stage lights will wash the color out of skin; all performers should apply heavy make-up for the performance. For children, some blush and lip gloss or lip color will do!

Stage/Tech Crew: These folks do various jobs such as run the sound and lights from the booth, run to get dancers, make sure dancers are ready to go on when needed, and make sure the performance goes well. Please be respectful to all crew members; they are there to make everyone look and feel good!

Food and Drink: There is no food or drink allowed inside of the gymnasium. We do encourage you to bring a clear liquid for the show, for the dressing areas only. Some healthy snacks and water will be provided. No sugary food please!

During the Show: All dancers remain backstage/in the dance room throughout the ENTIRE show. The dancers have a great time backstage seeing all the "big" dancers and feel special because they are allowed backstage and no one else is except performers. Also, if we need to contact a parent during the show, we will make an announcement over the microphone to locate the parent that is needed. Please do not come backstage/the dance room during the show.

After the Show: We ask all families to help put on our family and friend reception after the show. Below each class is listed and asked to bring recital day. If your class is asked to bring cookies please bring 2 dozen cookies or more. If your class is asked to bring drinks please bring 2 dozen juice boxes or small water bottles. Thank you in advance for your support and help putting on both recitals.
