



Summer Registration Details

We have adjusted our withdrawal and refund policies to allow more flexibility in the event last minute program cancellations are necessary or family plans change due to unforeseen circumstances due to COVID-19.

Key Dates Spring/Summer program registration opens Friday April 3rd. Early registration is recommended as most popular programs fill quickly.

Payments Full payment is due at the time of registration for most programs. Specific programs such as full day summer camps may allow the payment of a deposit at the time of registration in lieu of full payment to hold a space for the duration of the season.

Camp Deposits The following camps allow a deposit in lieu of full payment at the time of registration: Mini Si, Little Si, Big Si, RAD Jr, RAD, and TRAC camp. While deposits are generally non-refundable/non-transferable exceptions will be made in cases related to COVID-19, including facility closures and unforeseen family schedule changes. Open camp balances are due week prior to camp starting.

Payment Types All major credit cards are accepted. Si View Gift Cards are accepted online, or by phone. Due to COVID-19 related facility closures, in person payments are not accepted at this time.

Resident and Non-resident Fees Program fees are based on the residency status of patrons. Fees listed as R apply to those who reside within the boundaries of the Park District. Rates listed as NR apply to those residing outside Park District boundaries. For more information about the District and the boundary map, visit www.siviewpark.org/about-si-view.phtml.

Withdrawals For all programs, except camps that require a deposit, withdrawals requested 5 or more business days prior to the first class are subject to a \$10 administrative fee. Withdrawals requested less than 5 business days prior to the first class normally receive a 50% refund, exceptions will be made on a case by case basis in situations related to COVID-19. No refunds are issued after the first day of class. Full refunds are issued for classes cancelled due to low enrollment or emergency closures. Partial refunds are issued for classes cancelled after session start date due to emergency closures. Amount of refund is determined by number of course dates missed. See Camp Deposits section for camp withdrawal details.

Scholarships Everyone should have the opportunity to enjoy a recreational experience, even if money is a concern. Scholarships are available for youth and people with disabilities. Please be prepared to provide proof of residency in Snoqualmie Valley School District and income verification. Scholarship discounts are based on district resident prices.
