



## New Trail Connections Ready to Open to the Public

*Time to celebrate a growing connected trail network!*

You are invited to come celebrate the completion of new trail connections from Snoqualmie Valley Trail to Tollgate Farm Park and Meadowbrook Farm. On Friday June 28, a **ribbon cutting ceremony** will take place at 5pm, at the new Meadowbrook Trail, followed by a 3-mile **community walk** around Tollgate Farm Park. Refreshments will be available at the finish line at Meadowbrook Farm.

These two trail connections greatly improve pedestrian and bicyclist safety, eliminating the need to travel along the busy SR-202. The gravel surface trails meander through lush meadows with expansive views of the surrounding Cascade Mountains and provide new loop options for residents and visitors alike. These projects were a collaborative effort between Si View Metro Parks, City of North Bend, and Meadowbrook Farm Association, with financial support from King County Parks.

Si View Metro Parks is committed to continued work on the local trail network. Next year, a separated walking path will be added along North Bend Way linking Tollgate Farm Park to downtown North Bend.

Parking for the community walk is available at Meadowbrook Farm. Please dress for weather and wear comfortable shoes. Restrooms are available at Meadowbrook Farm and Tollgate Farm Park. Shuttle will also be available from Tollgate Farm back to the finish line for anyone looking for a shorter stroll. Walkers of all ages and abilities, strollers, bicycles, and leashed pets are all welcome and encouraged to attend!
